

Your Quick-Start Brick Patio Planning Checklist

1. Vision & Core Design

2. Site Preparation Essentials

- **Locate Underground Utilities: Call 811 (or your local equivalent)** before you dig—this is a non-negotiable step.
 - **Assess Site and Drainage:** Evaluate the natural slope and ensure proper water runoff is directed away from your home.
 - **Plan Excavation & Base:** Determine the necessary depth for your foundation, including gravel base and sand leveling bed.

3. Budget & Regulations

- **Check Permits & Regulations:** Confirm if your project requires local permits or falls under any HOA rules.
- **Estimate Your Budget:** Factor in all costs, including materials (bricks, base), tools, and potential labor costs if hiring.

- **Calculate & Source Materials:** Determine the quantities of bricks, gravel, and sand needed and plan where to purchase them.

4. Installation Strategy

- **Decide DIY vs. Pro:** Determine whether you have the skills and time to build it yourself or if hiring a professional is the best option.
 - **Choose Installation Method:** Will you use a dry-laid method (most common) or a mortar-set approach?
 - **Plan Edging:** Determine the edging restraint to secure your bricks in place.

- **Fill Joints Correctly:** Use sand or polymeric sand to stabilize bricks and prevent weeds from growing.
 - **Consider Sealing:** Decide if sealing your patio is beneficial for protection and longevity in your environment.
 - **Plan Ongoing Maintenance:** Think about how you'll regularly clean your patio and address any future weed growth.
